



DRAFT CONSTITUTION UPDATE

As has been mentioned to members previously, the Club has engaged Piggot Stinson to review the Clubs Constitution. The aim was to bring it in line with industry best practices as well as working in with the way we operate our Club and to include some items that members had been requesting. There have been a number of changes from the previous draft released in 2024.

The Board has arrived at what we feel is a Constitution all Wyong Leagues Group Members will be happy with. It updates some of the old provisions to fit in with 2025 expectations and legislation. It also addresses a number of requests from Rugby League members around our objects and includes different provisions from legislation directly in the Constitution to make it easier to find. This also makes clear the alignment between the legislation and the constitution.

Rather than an update to the existing Constitution, Piggot Stinson were given a blank slate to rewrite it from scratch.

The Board will consider all feedback received and from that come up with a final draft that will be put to a vote at a general meeting of members. Only eligible Rugby League members will be able to vote at that meeting.
